








PRIVILEDGE 39














The Grenadines are a super cruising ground and we would recommend a cruise that runs something like this:

join your yacht in St VIncent/Bequia

day 1: Bequia/Mustique

day 2: The Tobago Cays

day 3:Palm/Union Island for lunch stop and on to Mayreau

day 4:Canouan or St Vincent drop off depending on charter yacht selected

day 5 I would recommend either exploring the Tobago Cays islands for two nights or spending time ashore in the rainforest of St Vincent a complete contrast to your sailing days.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS.

We would also believe that you will get more from your charter by not trying to see too many islands and would highly recommend taking it easy on the first day with a short sail and lots of time to swim, snorkel and relax and get into the mood.

With the emphasis on activities and island exploration we would also suggest breaking the cruises for lunch stops and even spending two nights in the Tobago Cays - you can make a move within the Cays to change location and get completely different view. The Tobago Cays are the highlight of the region and the area has healthy supply of turtles and rays and the snorkeling is excellent and certainly deserves more than a passing glance.
